SJMS Cub Scout Pack 244 has been in existence for over 10 years. During this time the Pack has been the recipient of the Quality Unit award multiple years, most recently last year in 2009. We currently have around 12 Cub Scouts in our Pack but the program gets better and better with the more scouts involved! We camp out 2-3 times per year, participate in a variety of "Go See" events to learn about interesting places in our community, work on crafts and learn new skills during monthly Den meetings, and recognize each scout's advancement during monthly Pack meetings. The cost per scout is only about \$3 per month.

Fourth and Fifth grade scouts are Webelos

Cub Scouting is parent-scout directed so participation and interactions with your scout are key to enriching the experience for him. That said, the time commitment is fairly minimal. There are generally only 2 meetings per month (and in many cases we schedule these back-to-back so that scouting is a one night commitment each month).
